Dear Ms Reding.

We refer to our previous correspondence in this matter, particularly of January 20, 26 and 31, and March 7 2011.

The criminal acts / the perpetration of the bank's fraudulent activity in this matter has been duly documented and filed as criminal complaints with the Luxembourg public prosecutor. To our astonishment all complaints have been either shredded or shelved (most of them without even notifying us about the decision) on the grounds that these acts are lawful in Luxembourg. By sheer logic this means that the close to 20 year old cemented government of Luxembourg rules the country by means of anarchy.

Further investigation in this case has revealed additional criminal offences committed by Danske Bank International S.A. and Luxembourg officials.

In January 2011 we were, as you should know, facing an imminent foreclosure based upon a secret court order of May 21 2010, of which was kept secret from us for 6 months. When we attempted to fight this court order, we were deliberately deprived of our right to appeal and thus of our right to defend ourselves. For some reason or other, the perpetrators ceased their illegal actions based upon this criminal act of the Luxembourg Court of First Instance. Instead they continued the pursuit of us, this time fabricating another default/breach of contract and subsequently presenting a fraudulent document as a new legal basis for a foreclosure. These criminal acts are described in the enclosed criminal complaints and we would highly appreciate your engagement as all the democratic institutions in this country have clearly failed to function.
