We refer to our correspondence of January 20 and 26 2011 in this matter.

Please find enclosed our claim against Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF) of January 31 2011. This writ, together with its attachments, demonstrates how CSSF covers up and protects financial crimes and is in itself a documentation on organized crime of which the Government of Luxembourg is engaged in. As argued although it is beside the point in this matter - CSSF is responsible for the national financial crisis, and carries parts of the responsibility of the global financial crisis as well.

The judicial system in Luxembourg has proven to be corrupt to such an extent that this writ will most likely not even be served to CSSF. In this regard we refer to our previous correspondence documenting this legal situation, hence we petition the Commissioner or the Commission to investigate this matter with the aim of uncover who is obstructing; 1) our right to defend ourselves against private and public crimes, and 2) our right of having our lawsuits tried before a court of law, and why. Furthermore the Commissioner / Commission should initiate investigation upon the organized crime we have uncovered, as the national institutions which normally would have been responsible for such an investigation has ceased to function. We will highly appreciate your soonest response.
